

| COMMUNITY               | 5 Communities with Entertainment Definitions  |

| <b>Atlanta, GA</b>      | <b>Entertainment:</b> The live performance by any person, whether such person be a musician, dancer or otherwise, which occurs upon the premises of a licensed establishment.   |
| <b>Baltimore, MD</b>    | <b>Entertainment: Live</b> means 1 or more of any of the following, performed live by 1 or more persons, whether or not done for compensation and whether or not admission is charged: (i) musical act, including karaoke; (ii) theatrical act, including a play, revue, or stand-up comedy;(iii) dance;(iv) magic act;(v) disc jockey; or (vi) similar activity. “Entertainment: live” does not include any adult use.   |
| <b>Boston. MA</b>       | <b>Entertainment Uses:</b> adult entertainment; amusement game machines in commercial establishment; amusement game machines in noncommercial establishment; bar; bar with live entertainment; bowling alley; billiard parlor; dance hall; drive-in theater; fitness center or gymnasium; private club not serving alcohol; private club serving alcohol; restaurant with live entertainment not operating after 10:30 p.m.; or restaurant with live entertainment operating after 10:30 p.m.   |
| <b>Philadelphia, PA</b> | <b>Social entertainment purposes:</b> shall mean dancing, entertainment by live music or a disc jockey, observing a theatrical or other performance or similar activities. The phrase shall not include the consumption of food and beverages, listening to a speaker or lecture, watching television, watching or participating in athletic events, or other similar activities.   |
| <b>Phoenix, AZ</b>      | <b>Phoenix Downtown Code Definition for Outdoor Entertainment:</b> Outdoor events or performances that are open to the public and that feature visual art, music, dance, theater, performance art, science, design or cultural heritage subject to the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. The outdoor event or performance must be presented by an existing business on the property and must comply with all applicable codes and ordinances.</li> <li>b. The business’ regularly stocked items may be displayed outdoors and be available for purchase during the event or performance but payment for all items shall occur indoors. No other items may be displayed for sale outdoors during the event or performance.</li> </ul> |
