

COMMUNITY	10 COMMUNITIES WITH OUTDOOR DINING REGULATIONS FOR RESTAURANTS
Atlanta, GA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allowed, but no music or live entertainment outside.
Austin, TX	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 500 sq. ft. or less in size • 50' to single family residential
Baltimore, MD	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Compact area • Maintain 5' sidewalk clearance.
Chicago, IL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allowed, at grade and on roof tops with permit • Compatible with the are in terms of hours of operation, lighting, noise, traffic generation (established through special use permit).
Cincinnati, OH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Outdoor areas that are less than 100' from Residential requires a conditional use permit • Outdoor area within 500' of Residential can't exceed 50% of indoor area. • Outdoor areas within 500' of Residential can have no audio/visual equipment or sound amplification.
Davidson, NC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Outdoor seating limited to 50% of total seating capacity of restaurant. • 5' sidewalk clearance.
Greenville, SC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Outdoor café requires permit. No loudspeaker, radio, public address system, or sound amplifier. • Beer and wine only to seated patrons at tables.
Miami/Dade County, FL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 42" clearance for sidewalk passage. • No outdoor food preparation or cooking in Neighborhood Commercial districts. • Unamplified music permitted.
Phoenix, AZ	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allowed as accessory with a use permit. • Outdoor food prep and cooking requires a permit, and has conditions.
Raleigh, NC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Outdoor music permitted with public hearing and special use permit. • Outdoor music may be permitted along corridor 300' of any major or minor thoroughfare, interstate or Federal Aid Primary Highway. • Amplified entertainment permit required for interior.
