RE: ZONING APPROVAL FOR AN ADMINISTRATIVE DEVIATION

Dear Property Owner:

Your request for an administrative deviation has been **granted** to allow a one foot encroachment of the front porch on the principal building into the 30-foot required (front) setback, required by the Ordinance Section 9.205(1)(e2) and shown on a Physical Survey of the property provided by the applicant.

The following facts warrant approval of the administrative deviation request:

- 1. The proposed deviation was caused by an inadvertent error that occurred during the construction of the covered porch for the residential structure.
- 2. The applicant's physical survey prepared by Mark C. Carter, Land Surveyor, shows the encroachment into the 30-foot setback.
- 3. The setback encroachment was discovered when the above survey was completed.
- 4. The encroachment is minor and will not be easily detectable or visible.
- 5. The requested deviation is within the dimensional measurement allowed by Section 4.107(2) of the Zoning Ordinance.

The administrative deviation approval was granted under Section 4.107 (Delegated Authority) of the City of Charlotte Zoning Ordinance. If any permits are required, please make sure that the annotation of this section is noted on the permit application.
