## **RECOMMENDATION**

We have the following comments that are critical to CMS' support of this petition:

Adequacy of existing school capacity in this area is a significant problem. We are particularly concerned about rezoning cases where school utilization exceeds 100% since the proposed development will exacerbate this situation. Approval of this petition will increase overcrowding and/or reliance upon mobile classrooms at the schools listed below.

The total estimated capital cost of providing the additional school capacity for this new development is \$173,000, calculated as follows:

Middle School:  $4 \times $23,000 = $92,000$ High School:  $3 \times $27,000 = $81,000$ 

CMS recommends the petitioner schedule a meeting with staff to discuss any opportunities that the petitioner/developer may propose to improve the adequacy of school capacity in the immediate area of the proposed development.

## TOTAL IMPACT FROM PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

Proposed Housing Units: 134 townhomes under R-8 MF(CD) zoning

CMS Planning Area: 14

Average Student Yield per Unit: 0.1282 for Townhomes/Condos

This development will add approximately 17 students to three schools in this area.

## **INCREMENTAL IMPACT FROM PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT\***

Existing number of housing units allowed: 57 Single Family units under R-3 zoning

Number of students potentially generated under current zoning: 30 (15 elementary, 7 middle and 8 high)

The development allowed under existing zoning would generate 30 students, while the development allowed under the proposed zoning will produce 17 students. Since development of the property under existing zoning would generate more students that the proposed development, the incremental impact is 0.
