

COMMUNITY MEETING: Project Innovations, LLC Petition 06-73

Date of original contact: April 21, 2006

Persons contacted and explanation of how contacted: Meeting invitees were contacted by first class mail. (See attached letter and mailing list).

**Date, time and location of meeting:** The meeting was scheduled for 7:00 PM on May 4, 2006 at Kilgo United Methodist Church located at 2101 Belvedere Avenue.

Persons in attendance at the meeting: See attached Neighborhood Sign-In Sheet

Summary of discussion/issues discussed and changes to the petition as a result of the meeting: The meeting opened with a brief review of the rezoning process and conditional site plan. The plan consists of 14 condominium units, which will replace 3 duplex structures currently on the property. Proposed architectural elevations were also displayed. Due to the limited attendance the meeting was very brief and informal. (Please note that the petitioner held a previous neighborhood meeting with residents of Belle Terre Avenue). The following issues/questions were reviewed:

- . when will construction begin and how long to complete
- . how large is the development site
- . how tall will dwelling units be
- . will sidewalks be constructed along Belle Terre Avenue
- . increased traffic on Belle Terre

Residents who attended reacted favorably to the proposal. Replacing the three dilapidated duplex structures presently on the site with a small, upscale condo complex was viewed as a favorable change for the neighborhood and overall property values.

Minor changes and clarifications to the site plan resulted from comments received from staff.
