Parking
1. Off street parking will meet the minimum standards established under the 2. No parking deck may be constructed on the Site.

2. The maximum height of any freestanding lighting fixture including its base, shall not exceed 30 feet in height and will be fully shielded. 3. All direct lighting within the Site shall be designed such that direct liumination does not extend past any property line. Consideration will be given to the impact of lighting both within and without the perimeter of the Site. Items for consideration will include integral to the site. include intensity, cutoff angles color energy efficiency and shielding of sources of light the intent being to eliminate glare towards Mallard Creek Church Road, John Adams and adjacent properties.

4. No wall pack light fixtures will be allowed on any structures placed on the Site.

Signs
1. All signs placed on the Site will be erected in accordance with the requirements 2-crity one detached sign will be allowed for Parcer 4. 3. Detached sign will be a monument sign limited to 50 square feet in area and seven feet in height.

Access Point (Driveways) 1. The number of vehicular access points to the Site shall be limited to the number depicted on this Technical Data Sheet. 2. The placement and configuration of each access point are subject to any minor

modifications required to accommodate final site and architectural construction plans

and designs and to any adjustments required for approval by the County Engineering Department and the North Carolina Department of Transportation. 3. The parking lots for each of the establishments placed on the Site must be configured as shown and to allow internal vehicular traffic to move from Parcel 4 to the Parcels.

Fire Protection

Adequate fire protection in the form of fire hydrants will be provided to the Mecklenburg County Fire Marshal's specifications. Plans for each building will be submitted to the Fire Marshal's office for approval before the construction of that building commences.

Architectural Controls

a. Dumpster area will be enclosed on all four sides by a brick wall with one side being a hinged wooden gate. b. All mechanical equipment including roof top equipment shall be screened from

view from streets and adjoining properties. c. At least 75% of the elevations of all buildings constructed on the Site will consist of brick materials.

d. The design of the hotel shall incorporate interior corridors; exterior corridors shall be prohibited.

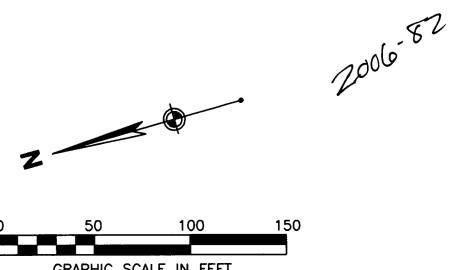
