Subject: Rezoning Petition 07-079: Located on the south side of North Tryon

Street (US 29) and the east side of Pavilion

Boulevard (Revised 09/21/07)

We previously commented on this petition in our May 30, 2007 memorandum to you.

Vehicle Trip Generation

This site could generate approximately 3,800 trips per day as currently zoned. Under the proposed zoning the site could generate approximately 8,800 trips per day. This will have a significant impact on the surrounding thoroughfare system.

The transportation improvements noted on in the Development Standards are consistent with recommendations in the TIS.

We have the following specific comments that are critical to CDOT's support of the rezoning petition:

- 1. 6-foot sidewalks and 8-foot planting strips should be provided on all internal public and private streets.(TAP-best practices) (*Previous Review Comment -3*)
- 2. Multiple direct connections to the Mallard Creek Greenway should be provided. (*Previous Review Comment -3*)
