We previously commented on this petition in our May 28, 2008 memorandum to you.

Consistency with Transportation Action Plan (TAP)

The TAP relies on the Centers, Corridors, and Wedges land use strategy to be implemented. This project site is located in a Corridor and appears to support the Centers, Corridors, and Wedges land use strategy.

Vehicle Trip Generation

With the array of uses allowed in I-2 and TOD zoning categories, a wide range of trip generation is possible for either the existing or proposed zoning scenarios. Given the size of the site, its proximity to the good street network in the area, CDOT feels that there should only be minor impacts to the transportation system resulting from this rezoning.

We have no remaining transportation issues with this petition.
