#### Floodplain (revised)

Thank you for acknowledging that "No fill may be placed within the Community or FEMA Floodplain."

The subject site has obtained a Letter of Map Revision based upon fill, aka LOMR-F, which removed a portion of the site from the FEMA Special Flood Hazard Area. The LOMR-F does not technically move the floodplain lines on the Flood Insurance Rate Maps but we recognize that the filled area is no longer in the floodplain. The FEMA base flood elevation in this area is 573.0 feet.

The intended use as an adult day care makes this a critical facility under the floodplain ordinance. Please acknowledge as appropriate and indicate on the plans how the critical facility conditions will be met as well as requirements related to dry land access and parking.
