

Community Meeting Report: August 25, 2009

Dear Ms. Cothran:

In response to your Email communications of July 31, I am writing to submit the report of our community meeting on this application.

On August 15, 2009, I prepared and mailed individual notices about our application and the community meeting scheduled on site at 6220 Thermal Road for Tuesday, August 25, 2009, from 5:30 pm until 7:00 pm. A copy of that notice is the first item attached; please note that relevant portions of the site plan were reproduced on the reverse side. These notices were sent to each of the individuals and groups identified on the mailing labels provided to me by the Planning Department, which are the second and third items attached. There were approximately 200 individual notices I sent, postage prepaid, to these persons and groups.

On August 25, 2009, at 5:30 pm, I was present on site, along with Ms. Cathy Harrison and Mr. John Patton of Alexander Youth Network. From 5:30 pm until after7:00 pm, one person attended the community meeting: Ms. Emily Bridgers, an employee at Alexander Youth Network. The sign-in sheet of the meeting is the fourth attachment to this letter. There were no other persons or group representatives from the surrounding neighborhood who attended the community meeting.

Ms. Bridgers asked about the anticipated wireless coverage from the telecommunications tower, and I shared with her the AT&T Mobility radio frequency coverage plots which I provided to the Planning Department previously along with our resubmitals on August 14. Questions were asked about the safety and location of the tower, and I reviewed the site plan which was on display at the meeting, including tower setbacks, aesthetics, fencing and security.

There are no changes to the rezoning petition as a result of the community meeting. Applicant has agreed to install opaque wood fencing around the equipment compound, in lieu of chain link fencing.
