Grier Heights Community Center at 3100 Leroy Street.

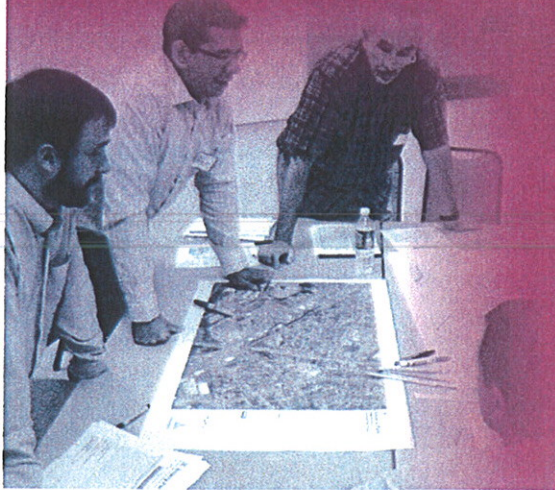

materials of the building and the fence surrounding the secure parking lot. The building materials consist of brick, block, cast
stone and FRP cornice. The secure fence will be a 6' black aluminum fence with intermediate brick posts. The idea of adding
something to represent Grier Heights was brought up and thought it was a good idea to incorporate it in the form of public art
that could be located in the plaza area along Wendover.
