

# Rezoning Petition 2010-079 PRE-HEARING STAFF ANALYSIS December 20, 2010

**REQUEST** Text amendment to Sections 2.201, 9.101, and 9.1103 of the Zoning

Ordinance.

**SUMMARY OF PETITION** The petition proposes to:

1) add a new definition for "eco-industrial facility";

2) modify the definition for "public utility structure"; and

3) allow eco-industrial facilities in light and general industrial zoning

districts, with prescribed conditions.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION Staff recommends approval of this petition. The petition is consistent

with the General Development Policies-Environment.

### Proposed Request Details

The text amendment contains the following provisions:

- Adds a new definition for "eco-industrial facility".
- Modifies the definition for "public utility structure" by allowing them to be publically owned or owned by a public-private partnership.
- Permits an eco-industrial facility in the I-1 and I-2 zoning districts, with prescribed conditions:
  - Minimum site size of 350 acres:
  - Site has direct rail access; and
  - The development standards of 9.1105 and Chapter 12 shall be met, including area, yard and bulk regulations, buffers and screening, signs, parking and loading, outdoor storage, setbacks and yards, dumpsters, solid waste containers, recycling containers, outdoor lighting, and security fencing.
