REQUEST Current Zoning: B-1, neighborhood business

Proposed Zoning: B-2, general business

LOCATION Approximately 3.69 acres located on the east side of Statesville Road

between Cindy Lane and Nevin Road.

DISCUSSION

Staff presented this conventional rezoning petition to the Zoning Committee. A Committee member questioned if there was a need for use limitations on the site. Staff responded that the proposed zoning designation was consistent with the land use recommendation and with surrounding B-2 and I-1(CD)zoning located along lots fronting

Statesville Road, which is a major thoroughfare.
