

Rezoning Petition 2011-075 PRE-HEARING STAFF ANALYSIS December 12, 2011

REQUEST Text amendment to Section 12.506 of the Zoning Ordinance

PLANNING STAFF REVIEW

Background

- The Zoning Board of Adjustment requested that the Zoning Ordinance be amended to clarify the street classification onto which a religious institution can front in the residential zoning districts.
- Section 12.506 places religious institutions located in residential districts into three categories small, medium and large based on the number of seats. For each category, there are maximum floor area ratios (FAR) and street classification frontage requirements.

Proposed Request Details

The text amendment contains the following provisions:

- There are no changes to the standards.
- The regulations related to street frontage have been rewritten to make the requirements clearer.
