Community Meeting Report SilverLake Rezoning Petition #2012-013

The meeting was held on February 8, 2012. Enclosed is the list of those persons and/or organizations, who were invited to attend the meeting. Also, a copy of one of the letters (all were identical). In the letter it included the date, time, and location of the meeting. There were two people, who attended this meeting and they signed the roster, which is included in this package.

They inquired what the rezoning entailed and why we are pursuing it. We explained that one of our tenants, Polygal, would like to expand their use in order to incorporate light manufacturing at this location. This tenant would like to extrude plastic in their facility rather than ship the large plastic sheets from Israel as they must do now, in order to save time and money. In addition they will be able to make larger sheets at the facility than what they are able to receive from oversees, which some of their customers need. Lawrence and Cindy Cartner did not have any objections to our rezoning. Also, two other neighbors called and neither had objections to our rezoning.

Polygal has told us that they may invest as much as \$10,000,000 in machinery. Over 3 and 5 years they anticipate hiring an additional 25 and 50 people, respectively. There would be no pollution, no gas emission, no smoke nor steam, and no vents would be necessary. Most importantly, Polygal is not requesting any incentives, but in order for them to remain in the facility, they must have this requested rezoning.
