REQUEST Current Zoning: B-D, distributive business

Proposed Zoning: B-2, general business

LOCATION Approximately 3.5 acres located on the east side of Red Oak

Boulevard near the intersection of Interstate 77 and West Arrowood

Road.

the B-2 district.
