

Rezoning Petition 2012-052 PRE-HEARING STAFF ANALYSIS June 18, 2012

REQUEST Current Zoning: I-2, general industrial

Proposed Zoning: I-1, light industrial

LOCATION Approximately 2.24 acres located on the west side of Kenley Lane

near the intersection of Griffith Road and Westpark Drive.

SUMMARY OF PETITION The petition proposes to rezone 2.24 acres to allow all uses in the I-1

zoning district.

Proposed Request Details

This is a conventional rezoning petition with no associated site plan.

Existing Zoning and Land Use

The subject parcel is zoned I-2 and developed with a commercial structure. The surrounding properties are zoned I-1 and I-2 developed with commercial uses.

Rezoning History in Area

There have been no rezonings in the immediate area in recent years.

 - The *Tyvola & Archdale Transit Station Area Plan* (2008) recommends office/industrial-warehouse distribution for the subject parcel.
