ZONING COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION April 24, 2013

REQUEST Current Zoning: B-1(CD), neighborhood business, conditional Proposed Zoning: TOD-M, transit oriented development-mixed use LOCATION Approximately 2.437 acres located on the west side of North Tryon Street at the intersection of J.W. Clay Boulevard and North Tryon Street. (Council District 4 - Barnes) SUMMARY OF PETITION The petition proposes all uses allowed within the TOD-M zoning district. The rezoning site is part of a larger 4.92-acre property rezoned in 1995 (rezoning petition 1995-20) from B-1SCD to B-1(CD), in order to accommodate 21,000 square feet of retail and 7,500 square feet of office.
