

Rezoning Petition 2013-064 PRE-HEARING STAFF ANALYSIS September 16, 2013

REQUEST Current Zoning: B-2, general business

Proposed Zoning: TOD-M, transit oriented development-mixed use

LOCATION Approximately 14.4 acres located on the southwest intersection of

Tom Hunter Road and North Tryon Street.

(Council District 4 - Barnes)

SUMMARY OF PETITION The petition proposes to allow all uses permitted within the TOD-M

zoning district.

Proposed Request Details

This is a conventional rezoning petition with no associated site plan.

Existing Zoning and Land Use

The subject property is developed with an automotive dealership in B-2 zoning. Properties on the both sides of N. Tryon Street are zoned R-3, R-4, R-12MF, R-17MF, B-D(CD), B-2 and B-2(CD) and contain single family and multi-family residential uses, commercial uses and vacant lots.

• Rezoning History in Area

There have been no rezonings in the immediate area in recent years other than the pending petition 2013-052, which is scheduled for public hearing in September 2013.

Public Plans and Policies

- The Blue Line Extension Transit Station Area Plan (2013), Tom Hunter Station, recommends transit supportive land uses (residential, office, retail, civic/institutional, park and open space) for this and surrounding parcels.
