REQUEST Current Zoning: B-1, neighborhood business

Proposed Zoning: TOD-M, transit oriented development, mixed-use

LOCATION Approximately 0.24 acres located on the east side of South

Boulevard near the intersection of Rensselaer Avenue and South

Boulevard.

(Council District 1 - Maddalon)

Proposed Request Details

This is a conventional rezoning petition with no associated site plan.

Existing Zoning and Land Use

The subject site is currently occupied by a commercial building. A multi-family development is located across South Boulevard and is zoned MUDD. All other surrounding properties contain commercial and office uses. These parcels are zoned TOD-M, B-1, and O-2.

Rezoning History in Area

There have been numerous rezonings in this area to accommodate various transit oriented developments.

- The South End Transit Station Area Plan (2005) recommends mixed use transit supportive development for the property. The site is located within the ¼ mile walk distance from the Bland Street transit station.
