Location of Property: Approximately 23.3 acres located along the southside of N Tryon

Street, between Wednesbury Blvd and Caprington Avenue.

Recommendations

Concerning Storm Water: The rezoning plan sheets indicate a "100-ft SWIM Buffer" on the

proposed site. Please revise the label to indicate it as a "Potential

100-ft Undisturbed PCSO Buffer."

Recommendations

Due to revisions (6/19/17): The rezoning plan sheets indicate a 200-ft Water Quality Buffer

along the channel at the western side. Please check and confirm potential buffer widths and locations. 200-ft Post Construction

Stormwater buffers are not located in this watershed.

The proposed site plan indicates a greenway trail system located within the 100-ft Undisturbed PCSO Buffer. Please include the following note under section 5. Environmental Features: "Development or disturbance within the PCSO Buffer shall be coordinated with Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services

and mitigated if required by City ordinance."

Recommendations

Due to revisions (7/27/17): No additional recommendations are needed at this time.
