IMPACT UNDER CURRENT ZONING

Number of housing units allowed under current zoning: the approximately 2.96 acres zoned R-3 conventional would allow approximately 8.88 residential dwellings.

The subject property is developed with five single family detached dwellings.

Number of students potentially generated under current zoning: 8 students (6 elementary, 1 middle, and 1 high).

IMPACT OF THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

Proposed Housing Units: the conditional UR-2(CD) district request seeks to allow 26 single family attached dwellings units.

RECOMMENDATION

Adequacy of existing school capacity in this area is a significant problem. We are particularly concerned about rezoning cases where school utilization exceeds 100% since the proposed development may exacerbate those situations. Approval of this petition may increase overcrowding and/or reliance upon mobile classrooms at the school listed above.





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The total estimated capital cost of providing the additional school capacity for this new development is \$27,000; calculated as follows:

Elementary School: $\mathbf{0} \times \$20,000 = \0

Middle School: **0** x \$23,000 = \$0

High School: 1x \$27,000 = \$27,000

CMS recommends that the petitioner/developer schedule a meeting with staff to discuss mitigation of the cost to improve the adequacy of school capacity at the potentially affected schools.

The future project, below, is included on the *CMS 2017 Bond Projects* list, as approved by county voters:

1. construction of a new 125-classroom high school in March 2021 to relieve South Mecklenburg, Ardrey Kell, <u>Myers Park</u>, and Olympic high schools (tentative date; location to be determined).
