IMPACT OF THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

Proposed Housing Units: the R-3 to UR-2(CD) petition proposes the development of up to 110 single-family, attached (townhome) units.

CMS Planning Area: 10, 11, 12, 13

Average Student Yield per Unit: 0.1718

This development may add 19 student(s) to the schools in this area.

The following data is as of 20th Day of the 2017-18 school year.

RECOMMENDATION

Adequacy of existing school capacity in this area is a significant problem. We are particularly concerned about rezoning cases where school utilization exceeds 100% since the proposed development may exacerbate those situations. Approval of this petition may increase overcrowding and/or reliance upon mobile classrooms at the schools listed above.

The total estimated capital cost of providing the additional school capacity for this new development is \$430,000; calculated as follows:

Elementary School:9x \$20,000 = \$180,000Middle School:5x \$23,000 = \$115,000High School:5x \$27,000 = \$135,000



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CMS recommends that the petitioner/developer schedule a meeting with staff to discuss mitigation of the cost to improve the adequacy of school capacity at the potentially affected schools.

- 1. Beginning in the 2018-2019 school year, the middle school assignment for students in the subject area (with some exceptions) will change from Community House Middle School to Quail Hollow Middle School.
- 2. Construction of a new 125-classroom high school to relieve <u>South Mecklenburg</u>, Ardrey Kell, Myers Park, and Olympic high schools is projected to begin in March 2021 (tentative date; location to be determined).
- 3. The *CMS 2017 Bond Projects* list includes the renovation or replacement of two South Mecklenburg High School classroom buildings beginning June 2023 (tentative date).
