COMMUNITY MEETING REPORT PETITIONER: NOVANT HEALTH, INC. REZONING PETITION NO. 2019-035 DATE OF MEETING: APRIL 11, 2019

This Community Meeting Report is being filed with the City of Charlotte Planning Office pursuant to the provisions of the City of Charlotte Zoning Ordinance.

<u>PERSONS AND ORGANIZATIONS CONTACTED WITH DATE AND EXPLANATION</u> OF HOW CONTACTED:

A representative of the Petitioner mailed a written notice of the date, time and location of the Community Meeting to the individuals and organizations set out on Exhibit A attached hereto by depositing such notice in the U.S. mail on March 27, 2019. A copy of the written notice is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

DATE, TIME AND LOCATION OF MEETING:

The Community Meeting was held on Thursday, April 11, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. at Lower Providence Community House, 9735 Community House Road, Charlotte, NC 28277.

PERSONS IN ATTENDANCE AT MEETING (see attached copy of sign-in sheet):

The Community Meeting was attended by the persons identified on the sign-in sheet attached hereto as Exhibit C. Each attendee was provided a copy of the Agenda, attached hereto as Exhibit D. Petitioner Novant Health, Inc. was represented at the Community Meeting by R. Susanne Todd, attorney with Johnston, Allison & Hord, PA, Matt Stiene, Vice President of Engineering for Novant Health, Inc., Kevin Gorman, Senior Project Manager with Alfred Benesch & Company, and Randy Goddard, Traffic Engineer with Design Resource Group.

SUMMARY OF PRESENTATION/DISCUSSION:

The meeting began at 6:08 p.m. when Petitioner's agent, R. Susanne Todd, welcomed the attendees and introduced the petitioner's team. Ms. Todd indicated that the Petitioner proposed to rezone an approximately 38 acre site (the "Site") located at the southeast corner of Johnston Road and Providence Road West, Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, NC from R-3 zoning district to O2(CD) zoning district. Ms. Todd explained that Novant Health, Inc. intends to construct a medical office building and hospital on the Site.

Matt Steine described the proposed plan for a 36-bed, 3-story hospital and office building. He pointed out the 3 planned entrances to the site on the building rendering.

- Q. Will there be cut throughs in adjacent neighborhoods for the ambulances?
- A. Randy Goddard discussed the traffic intersections and proposed right-out and left-in entrances/exits. He recommended the homeowners contact the Public Services Division to let them know of their concerns.


- Q. Will there be siren and helicopter noise?
- A. The helicopter pad will only be used to transport patients <u>from</u> the facility for treatment/surgery that can best be handled at the main hospital downtown. Emergency airlifts from a trauma will be taken to the main hospital.
- Q. Will there be a lot of lighting around the facility?
- A. There will not be "football stadium" lighting, but rather regular street lights only inside the property line. Matt offered to take anyone interested on a tour of the Mint Hill facility at night to observe the lighting and the layout. Novant wants to be a trusted community partner, which is the purpose of having the community meeting to hear the concerns of the adjacent homeowners.
- Q. Why was the emergency entrance not placed on Hwy 521?
- A. Originally, Hwy 521 was not an option per the DOT. The traffic patterns have not been finalized yet. This is something that can be discussed further with the DOT.
- Q. Will there be walking access to and from the site?
- A. There will be a 75-foot buffer with a fence, so pedestrians on the site cannot walk directly into neighboring back yards.
- Q. The residents used to enjoy family activities on the farm. Is anything planned in this regard?
- A. There will be walking paths integrated onto the campus.
- Q. What does Novant plan to do with the 18-acres next to the Grace Christian property across the street?
- A. Nothing is planned for that yet. They are just holding it for now. If any future development is decided, there will be another community meeting to discuss it with the adjacent owners.
- Q. What does Novant plan to do with the pond on the site?
- A. Nothing can be built on the wetlands and pond area. It will need to remain in some form for drainage. This issue still needs to be evaluated.
- Q. Does Novant plan to have the land surrounding the planned buildings subdivided so as to be able to sell to a retail developer?
- A. There are no plans to subdivide and sell. It is one parcel.
- Q. Will there be another community meeting once the traffic patterns have been determined?
- A. Yes. Right now construction traffic will enter from Hwy 521.
- Q. How much additional traffic is expected to result from the facility?
- A. The Mint Hill facility has a staff of 300, which is expected on this site. The employees work 12-hours shifts from 7:00 to 7:00. This should not disrupt the residents who work regular 8:00 to 5:00 jobs.

- Q. What is the timeline?
- A. Construction is planned to start in 2020 lasting 18 months. The facility should be open for business by late 2023.
- Q. Where will the utilities come from?
- A. That has not been determined yet.
- Q. Will Bryant Farms Road be extended to Providence Road West?
- A. Per the DOT, this is not in their plans.

When attendees had no further questions, the meeting was adjourned at 7:06 P.M.


