- Monopines: Don't like the skimpy trees. They need to be higher than the trees for reception. Using a monopine should be decided site specific, with input from nearby residents. Like monopoles in the right setting, for concealment purposes.
- Has seen antenna array inside Duke Energy Hi-tension towers near Birkdale, in adjoining jurisdiction. Investigate.
- Want the preferences table like Cary, NC
- Want concealment regulations.
- Allow on building roofs.
- Collocation
- Want landscaping/screening that isn't too close to the fence/wall surrounding the tower. What about magnolia trees?
- Want an enclosure around the base of the tower and equipment facility.
- Don't want the equipment facility to be a fake house (Raleigh)
- Heights, setbacks, yards okay.
